INSTRUCTION SHEET for boarding

Please bring enough food in a resealable container to last your dogs stay. We are happy to feed raw if your dog is on that diet. **Do not bring dishes.** If you wish to bring treats please do so. These may be added to the communal treat jar and shared with everyone on our walks and at bedtime.

We will provide blankets and towels for your dogs stay. If you wish to bring something from home that smells like home please make sure it is not valuable. We are not responsible for damage done to anything that will be left with the dog. Also please let us know if your dog rips up beds or eats things.

Please bring your dog in to the kennel on leash and then take the leash home with you. **Your leash and harness will be sent home with you. We are not responsible for harnesses that are damaged or chewed if you determine they should stay with the dog.**

All of our walks are off leash with a group of dogs. We can walk them alone or on leash if necessary but prefer to walk them together. If your dog does not get along with other dogs they will not be happy here.

Please bring bark collars if they are used to using them. Please feel free to email when you are away for an update of your dogs time. We will try to respond within 24 hours.

Our drop off and pick up times are between 8am and 9am, 11am and 12 pm and 4:30pm and 6pm seven days a week.. Please tell us what time you will be coming.. We are closed Christmas day and New Years day. Payment is required when you pick up your dog.

You will be sent an invoice via email the morning of your dogs departure day. You can pay with e-transfer to the email address that the invoice is attached to. Cash or check (Made out to Dragonluck Kennels) are also fine.

We do not request specific vaccines as some of our dogs cannot have vaccines due to severe allergic reactions or age. We will expect that you and your vet have determined what is best for your dog and that you are aware that all the owners are doing the same and that your risk is the same as walking in dog parks etc. We do need to know the date of the last rabies shot.
